# REDUCING YOUR ENERGY BILLS AND CARBON FOOTPRINT.



The Green Homes Grant Local Authority Delivery scheme aims to reduce carbon emissions and support our ambition to become Carbon Neutral by 2028.

This will be achieved by improving the energy efficiency of homes within Nottingham, by aiming to increase your home's Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) rating to level C, which will significantly reduce your energy bills. A high EPC rating (D – G) means it may be difficult to keep your home warm.

## Eligibility:

- The property is located within the Nottingham City Boundary
- The occupier is the home owner or, the property is privately rented
- The home has a low Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) rating of D, E, F or G
- The household income is less than £30,000 per year (including any income related benefits)
